



BY-LAWS

We respectfully ask you to abide by the by-laws to help protect and preserve the Hurst and keep it a safe and enjoyable place for everyone.

- Wildlife should not be disturbed.
- Dogs must be kept under proper control, particularly in the nesting season for ground-nesting and water birds.
- No cars, motorcycles, mopeds or other motor vehicles of any description are allowed.
- Cycles should be used with due care and consideration for other users of the meadows.
- No fires or barbecues of any description are allowed on the meadows.
- No litter should be discarded in or on the meadows or in the river. All litter should be taken home.
- Damage to the Hurst Water Meadow, including the river banks, trees, meadows and fences is strictly forbidden.
- No shooting is allowed on the meadows.
- No camping or overnight stay is allowed.
- To preserve the tranquillity of the meadows, only devices playing music using earphones are allowed. No radios or other electronically amplified music is allowed.
- Metal detectors are not permitted unless authorised in writing by the County Archaeologist and the trustees.
- Fishing is allowed in season (16 June to 14 March) – please see more details under 'Fishing' in the 'What we offer' section of our website.
