Season and annual costs

The water meadow is available between 16th June and 14th March inclusive. A permit is required for all anglers.

Environmental Agency (EA) rod licence

An EA rod licence is also needed and is available from Post Offices or EA online.

Extent of fishing waters

- **River Thame south bank** from A to B.
- **The Mill Stream** from C (by old willow) to D. The bank here is eroded and unsafe. (Note that fishing is not available in the Overy mill pool.) The land to the west of our boundary (highlighted with red lines) is privately owned. Fishing the river Thame between points B and D is not permitted at present.
- When school visits are on the meadow, normally on a Wednesday during school time, you are requested to leave the northern area by the oak tree free.
- Buck Pool eastern bank (over weir and sluice bridges). **No fishing: private land.**

Please respect the countryside in this conservation area.

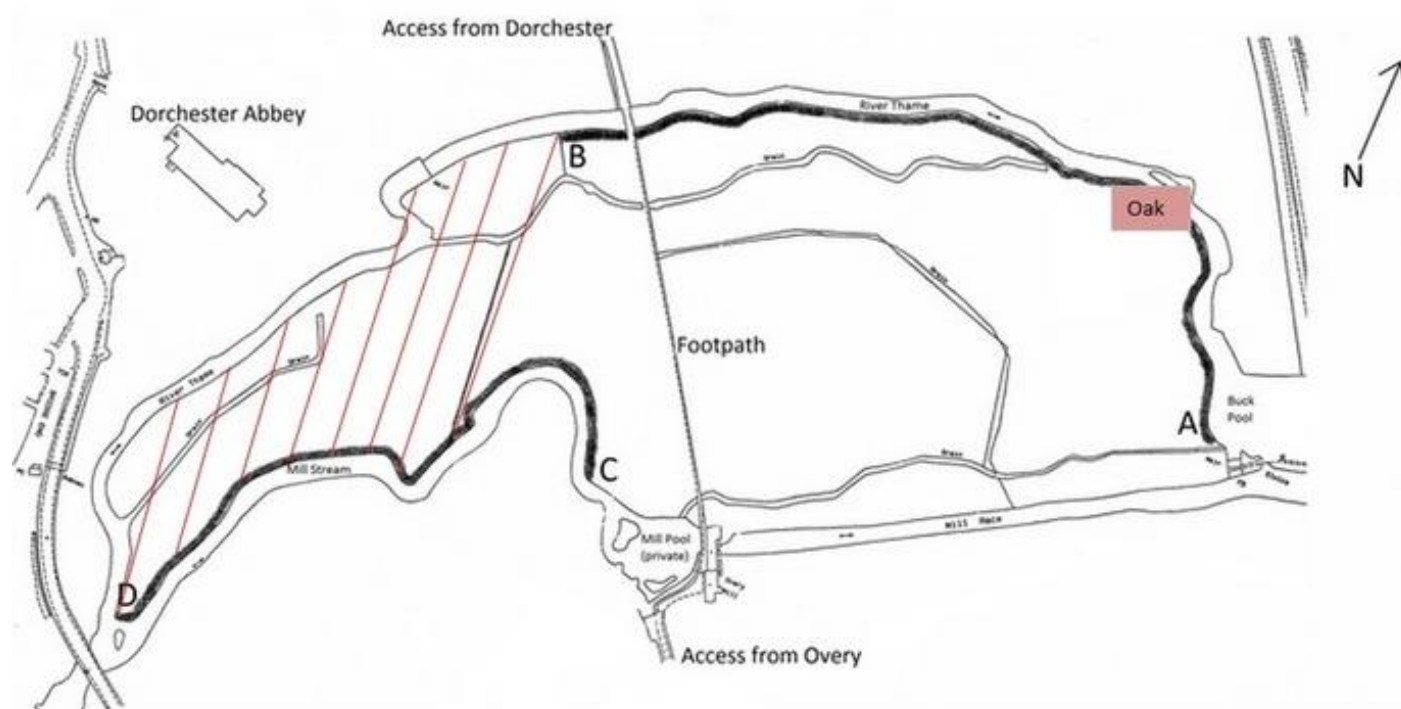
- Please take your litter home.
- Please leave the river banks and trees as you found them.
- Please do not light fires.
- Please return all fish to the water immediately.
- Please do not use lead weights or discard any fishing line in the water or on the bank. Both can be lethal to birds and other wildlife.



Parking

- Cars can be parked beside the school wall in Manor Farm Road, or in the public car park at Bridge End.
- Please do not bring cars down the lane. Cars are strictly forbidden on the meadow.
- Please do not park at the end of Manor Farm Road or by Overy Mill where it may cause inconvenience to residents.
- Please do not park on Dorchester Bypass (**it is illegal**) or gain access to the meadow from the bypass.
